


ACTIVE VOICE TO PASSIVE VOICE

Present Simple: am/is/are + past participle

They **make** cheese in Holland. = Cheese **is made** in Holland.



Present Continuous: am/is/are + being + past part.

They **are building** a new bridge. = A new bridge **is being built**.



Past Simple: was/were + past participle

The President **opened** the new museum.

The new museum **was opened** by the President


Past Continuous: was/were + being + past participle

They **were painting** the kitchen. = The kitchen **was being painted**.

Present Perfect: has/have + been + past participle

Bad weather **has delayed** the plane.

The plane **has been delayed** by bad weather



Past Perfect: had + been + past participle

They **had broken** the vase. = The vase **had been broken**.

Will-Future: will + be + past participle

They **will pay** us soon. = We **will be paid** soon.



Be going to-Future: am/is/are + going to + be + past part.

We're **going to rent** a car. = A car **is going to be rented**.

Modals (may, might, can, could, must, etc): modal + be + p.p.

You **must wear** a uniform. = A uniform **must be worn**.

You **can buy** newspapers here. = Newspapers **can be bought** here.




