Turn into passive:

Present Simple

We eat a lot of fish.
A lot of fish is eaten (by us).

Many pupils dislike school.
School is disliked (by many pupils).

Lions kill many animals.
Many animals are killed (by lions).

We often drink tea.
Tea is often drunk (by us).

Burglars often steal things.
Things are stolen (by burglars).

Joe makes baskets.
Baskets are made (by Joe).

Julie reads newspapers every day.
Newspapers are read every day (by Julie).

He reads many books yearly.
Many books are read yearly (by him).

We make fine cakes.
Fine cakes are made (by us).

I call my aunt often.
My aunt is often called (by me).

Future Simple

We will eat a lot of fish.
A lot of fish will be eaten (by us).

Many pupils will dislike school.
School will be disliked (by many pupils).

Lions will kill many animals.
Many animals will be killed (by lions).

We will drink a lot of tea.
A lot of tea will be drunk (by us).

Burglars will steal many things.
Things will be stolen (by burglars).

Joe will make baskets.
Baskets will be made (by Joe).

Julie will read newspapers.
Newspapers will be read (by Julie).

He will read many books.
Many books will be read (by him).

We will make fine cakes.
Fine cakes will be made (by us).

I will call my aunt tomorrow.
My aunt will be called (by me).
